

ARRAS 21st FILMFESTIVAL

REGULATIONS • ArrasDays • Fiction • Feature films

1. Dates

The 21st edition of the Arras Film Festival will take place from November 6-15, 2020. The 9th edition of the ArrasDays, organized within the Arras Film Festival, will take place from November 14-15, 2020.

2. Selection

The selection committee of the Festival, under the responsibility of the General Delegate, will select 7 or 8 European film projects (feature films, fiction only). Film projects will have priority if the director has a film selected for the European Competition or the European Discoveries Sections. Treatments at least 10 pages in length, scripts, storyboards and works in progress will be accepted.

3. Jury and Prize

For ArrasDays, the Festival will appoint one jury composed of three European professionals who will see each participant during a 30-minutes closed 'speed dating' session. This jury will award projects provided with a 7.500 € reward, offered by the Festival for the 1st best and 5.000 € reward, offered by the City of Arras for the second best, for development of the winning projects. The allocation of a special mention will give place to no subsidy.

4. Preselection

To participate in the preselection, the project as mentioned in item 2 must be sent by email, nor later than October 5, 2020, at the following address:

5. Films Project admitted for the Official Selection

The selection of film projects will be announced nor later than October 14, 2020. Any information, which may be useful for the Festival team and the Jury, must be sent along with the entry form fully completed and signed.

6. Generality

This regulation is written in French and English. In case of contesting about the interpretation of the text, the French will once. The Festival management reserves the right to take any decision on issues not covered by this Regulation. A request to participate in the ArrasDays organized by the Arras Film Festival imply unconditional acceptance of this Regulation. Any contesting will be settled by Arras Civil Court only.
